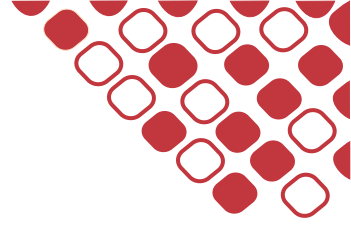

### TRAINING FOR HEALTHCARE PROFESSIONALS

### LIFE SKILL TRAINING

About 92 % of sudden cardiac arrest victims die before reaching the hospital, but statistics prove that if more people knew CPR, more lives could be saved. Immediate CPR can double, or even triple, a victim's chance of survival. It is our moral objective to save lives and to achieve this objective, we provided the most valuable training in healthcare setup, i.e. Cardio Pulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) Training at our organization. The training session was followed by a hands on practice. Ventilator as well as Bio Medical Equipment training for Para Medical and Nursing staff was organized to further improve skills on using and maintaining Bio Medical Equipment wisely.



# NEW IN EDITION

## DO IT YOURSELF (DIY)

We have brought to you few DIY ideas for you to try to decor your home during Diwali with kids and family.



### Diwali Kandil

#### You Need:

- ❖ Card paper (any colour)
- ❖ Glue or tape
- ❖ Colour papers or strips (choice of colour)
- ❖ Embroidery Materials
- ❖ Decorative items
- ❖ Scissor
- ❖ Thread or Ribbon

#### Method for DIY:

- ❖ Cut the card board paper into square shape and fold it in cylinder shape with the help of glue or tape.
- ❖ Prepared square shape of card papers as shown in image 2 and fold it in cone shape as shown in image 3 and stick it on cylinder shape.
- ❖ Apply decorative materials (embroidery, etc.) as shown in image 4 & 5.
- ❖ Stick bright color combination of strips or colour paper and stick it from inside the cylinder (image 5).
- ❖ Hang the Kandil with the help of ribbon or strong thread.(image 6).
- ❖ Your Diwali Kandil is ready for use.



### Candle Holder Decoration :

#### You Need:

- ❖ Designer tape (easily available in stationary shops)
- ❖ Scissor
- ❖ Candle holder (glass)

#### Method for DIY:

- ❖ Place the Candle/Diya holder and cut and paste designer tape on the glass in any design you like.
- ❖ Place the candle in the glass.
- ❖ One is made for you in image.

### Diya Decoration:

#### You Need:

- 🔥 Card paper (any colour)
- 🔥 Butter paper / Tracing Paper
- 🔥 Pencil & Eraser
- 🔥 Print of your choice for artwork
- 🔥 Glue or tape

- 🔥 Softboard pins
- 🔥 Scissor
- 🔥 Diya

#### Method for DIY:

- 🔥 Cut the card paper in square shape and put the arti craft print on the butter paper and trace with the help of pencil and make an image on card paper.
- 🔥 Pierce the soft board pins on the edges of print and make a small hole as shown in image 1.
- 🔥 Fold the cardboard in cylinder shape and place it on the lightening Diya. See the printed image.

The main objective of GCRI digital Library is to minimize the distance between Users, Resources and Library services.

**How it is done:** GCRI digital library has been managed through open sources software “E-Resource Search module for Library” with using tools: Apache version 2.4.9, Php Version: 5.5.12, Server software Apache /2.4.9, Wamp server, MySql version: 5.6.7.

**The Facilities:** Using GCRI Digital Library facility users can avail or access all digital resources on their desktop or laptop anywhere in the GCRI campus. Availability of information and data at no time to the users has become a reality after introduction and successful implementation of GCRI Digital Library with the following aspects -

• Accessibility of online Databases like: ProQuest (Online full text medical E-journals package), UpTo Date (Online clinical decision support system) and Ovid (Oncology Wolters Kluwer E-Journals)

- Availability of Oncology E- Books and E- Journals.
- Availability of Institutional Publication like-PhD Thesis, DM, MCH & MD Dissertation, Articles, Papers, Book chapters, Monographs etc.
- Availability of detailed library information database viz: Rules, Guidelines, Membership form & other institutional forms
