
WhatsApp Business Account

Safety - Staff and Patients


- Thermal screening/temperature screening made compulsory for employees/doctors/patients at the entry gate.



Older people, and those with underlying medical problems like cardiovascular disease, diabetes, chronic respiratory disease, and cancer are more likely to develop serious illness. 

World Cancer Day

A team of resident doctors (**Dr. Asha Solanki** & **Dr. Sahil Solanki**), intern doctors and medical social worker organized oral health examination for males and breast examination screening for females followed by health education sessions to raise awareness in the community about oral & breast cancer and ways to prevent the same on 4 February'20 on the occasion of World Cancer Day (7th February). A total of 25 male & 42 female participants got benefitted from this activity at Ghanchi ni Chali (street) near Ashok Mill, Ahmedabad.





National Dewarming Day

On the occasion of National Deworming Day 2020, a health education session was organized by Urban Health Training Centre, Department of Community Medicine, GCS Medical College, Ahmedabad at Marathi School No.-1, Asarwa, Ahmedabad on 10 February'20. Around 50 students of Standards 1 to 8 along with 4 school teachers, 1 Anganwadi supervisor, 4 Anganwadi staff and few parents were present to get knowledge. The session was followed by the distribution of pamphlets related to Deworming. 



Department of Obstetrics and Gynaecology participated in PG FORCE program at N.H.L. Municipal Medical College on 15-16 February'20.






A 60-Year-old male patient presented to general surgery OPD with major complaints of abdominal discomfort and occasional vomiting. After investigation on CECT abdominal scan suggestive of mass involving pylorus of stomach and duodenum. UGI scopy guided biopsy confirmed it to be moderately differentiated adenocarcinoma.

So after preoperative assessment of the patient, distal gastrectomy with pancreaticoduodenectomy (Whipple's Surgery) was done by Dr. M. V. Pipalia and team. Pancreatico-jejunostomy, choledocho-jejunostomy, and gastrojejunostomy were done.

The patient started a liquid diet on the 4th post Operative day and soft diet on 8th post-Operative day and was discharged uneventfully.



Training

Two nurses from Australia visited hospice at Community Oncology Centre (COC), during 24-31 January'20. (APLI) Australia Palliative link International supports the posting of these nurses in India under project "Hamrahi". They trained our nurses for various nursing care of hospice patients.
