CLINICAL CASES

Anaesthesia Pheochromocytoma Resection Case

A pheochromocytoma resection is a challenge for an anaesthesiologist as it is associated with wide hemodynamic fluctuation peri-operatively. A 29-year-old male patient was posted for bilateral Adrenalectomy surgery. Pre-Operatively, the patient was on tablet phenoxybenzamine and tablet metoprolol for one month. On the operation table, the patient appeared with hypertensive crisis with blood pressure 250/150 mm of hg, optimized with Injection labetalol 20 mg IV slowly. For beat to beat blood pressure monitoring, an arterial line was placed and general anaesthesia was administered along with CVP line and epidural catheter. Intraoperative hemodynamics was immensely stable even during manipulation of adrenal mass. None of vasopressor or hypotensive agent support was needed during the entire surgical course. After the completion of the procedure, the patient was extubated safely. The patient was discharged after good post-operative care. Anaesthetic management done by Dr. Dhara Shah, Dr. Heena Chhanwal, Dr. Sejal Parmar, Dr. Sanjay and team. Thanks to Dr. Jaimish Gajjar and the Surgery Unit - 3 team.

Patient with rare nose cancer operated at GCS Hospital

GCS Hospital's Dr. Pramod Menon (Consultant- Plastic, Cosmetic & Reconstructive Surgeon) and Dr. Aditya Joshipura (Consultant- Onco Surgery) performed Head & Neck surgery of a patient. The patient came at hospital with cancer of the nose with swellings in the neck. He was taking treatment for ulcer on nose since 2 years and was later diagnosed as squamous cell carcinoma of nose (rare cancer of nose). He was advised surgery in which nearly whole of his nose was to be removed along with removal of neck swellings (lymphnodes). This was to be followed with reconstruction of the nose. For this complex surgery two of our consultants collaborated. Dr. Aditya Joshipura (Consultant-

Onco Surgery) removed the nose along with the cancer and neck nodes. The completion of cancer removal was confirmed by frozen section. The nose was reconstructed by Dr. Pramod Menon (Consultant- Plastic, Cosmetic & Reconstructive Surgeon). Who used bone from hip to form a frame work and flap from the forearm to make the nose. The blood vessesls were joined in the neck. Patient was managed in ICU for 2 days days where Intensivist Dr. Shivang Patel & Dr. Vidhi Patel took good care of him and later shifted to ward n discharged healthily on 8th day of admission. GCS Hospital has all Super speciality & General Speciality Services with Complex to Minor surgery assistance.


DRDO Dhanvantari organizes Medical Officers training

This was when there were very few laboratories which had started RT PCR testing in Gujarat. The laboratory was working 24 hrs with handful of staff members. She also participated in creating musical therapy and motivating the patients with yoga asana for COVID-19 patients who were admitted in isolation and wards for their recreation.





Microbiology Laboratory-GCRI Covid Testing During The Pandemic

The COVID-19 pandemic started in April'20 and there were few Microbiology laboratories which were assigned to perform RT-PCR testing for the population and the patients. There was scarcity of laboratories to cater to Government needs. Under the able guidance of the Director, GCRI went ahead to take a lead to establish COVID-19 laboratory overnight.

The QC testing was performed by Dr.Parijat Goswami, which was qualified and passed by NIV, Pune. COVID laboratory a part of Microbiology Laboratory under the active guidance of Dr.Parijat N. Goswami, Professor and Head of Laboratory was working 24 x 7 and contributed to around 17,000 samples from April to October 2020 from districts of Banaskantha, Deesa, Kheda, Mehsana, Palanpur, Sabarkantha.

We restarted again in the second wave of the pandemic of COVID in April'21 and we are continuing with the performance of the test for the samples being received from Kheda district. We have performed around 27,800 samples testing this year. In total we performed around 44,735 samples testing till date.
