




The GCSMCH&RC family welcomes **Dr. Jagdish Khoyani** as **Chief Operating Officer** (**COO**). With

Orthopedics: Case study: Post-Surgical brachial plexus injury and physiotherapy.

A 49-Year-old female presented to GCS Hospital in an Orthopedics department with Complain of Pain in both Elbows on the movement of the joint aid restricted movement of both elbow joints for 5 years. The patient was relatively asymptomatic before 5 years then the patient developed pain over both elbows on movement and restricted mobility at both elbow joints. The pain was insidious in onset, dull aching, and continuous. The pain was exaggerated on the movement of both Elbows joints. The patient particularly had difficulty in pronation and supination of both forearms. The patient's examination revealed varus deformity at both elbow joints, Patient took outside medications and had temporary relief, but no improvement was noticed by her. hence, patient presented to GCS Hospital for consultation and further management. At GCS Hospital, the Patient was diagnosed with Bilateral osteoarthritis of the Elbow. After Proper consultation and counseling, patient was planned for left Elbow replacement on 09 Feb'22. The patient Underwent left elbow replacement following which the patient was discharged. On subsequent follow-ups and visible improvement in terms of both the magnitude of pain relief and elbow movements, the Patient was then planned for Right Elbow replacement on 13 May'22. She was operated on for right elbow replacement on the planned date. On follow-ups, patient showed good progress and altered great improvements in terms of both Elbow movements as the Patient could perform routine work without any hindrance.
